Your yard has been scheduled for insecticide treatment - FOLIAGE

The insecticide Tempo® Ultra SC, containing the active ingredient beta cyfluthrin, will be applied to above ground leafy foliage of ornamental plants to control Japanese beetle adults. Please be sure to follow all the Before and After treatment steps.

Application Date: _____ **Approximate Time:** Morning Afternoon

Applicator: Eco Life

There will be two foliar treatments with Tempo® scheduled about 7 - 10 days apart. You will receive advance notice for the second treatment 48 – 72 hours prior to the planned application.

You do not have to be present during the treatment as long as the applicators have access to your property, including the backyard, and you have made arrangements for all family members, including pets, to be out of the yard until reentry is possible.

Before Treatment

Close all windows and turn off or adjust your window air conditioning unit so that it does not draw air in from outside during the Tempo® application. Cover if you desire.

Move or cover cars, etc. from under trees to keep clear of any overspray. If you choose to cover these items, use an inexpensive, disposable plastic painting drop cloth. Dispose of in garbage can. Do not reuse. Exposed items should be rinsed following application.

Please move any barbeques, lawn furniture, trampolines, toys and other miscellaneous items away from your trees and shrubs. Cover large or stationary items if desired. Exposed items may be washed after spray treatment.

Remove pet food and water dishes.

Thoroughly and securely cover any water feature that contains fish or other aquatic animals.

Keep family members and pets indoors during the application on your property and until the After Treatment steps have been completed.

After Treatment

Wait until the foliage has dried before allowing family and pets to use your yard.

Carefully dispose of any tarp material used by folding the contaminated surface inside, place in a second plastic bag and put in the garbage

Encourage careful hand washing.

Avoid contact with the wet Tempo® mixture on you skin and eyes. If skin contact is made, rinse the affected area thoroughly with water for 15 - 20 minutes. If the material should get into your eyes, flush gently with water for 15 to 20 minutes. Remove contacts lenses, if present, after first 5 minutes.
