Please bring a calculator and if needed, reading glasses for the afternoons of the workshops.

If your pesticide license expires this year, it is your responsibility at the time you renew your license to (1) earn the appropriate CEUs (see bottom of this page) and provide paper copies that show the CEUs earned during the past three years and/or (2) retake and pass the necessary licensing examinations.

UDAF offers these workshops with approved pesticide **CEU's** (1 CEU equals one hour of training) on the dates and at the locations listed below. These workshops allow licensed pesticide applicators to earn a maximum of 6 CEUs annually, complete some category testing, and/or pay license renewal fees.

The employer(s) of a licensed Utah Commercial Pesticide Applicators must also have a current pesticide business license from UDAF for a person to secure or renew an applicator's license. The annual cost of a Utah pesticide business license is \$75 for companies with 1 to 4 applicators, \$150 for 5 to 9 applicators, or \$300 for 10 or more.
