

Beecheck – Apiary Registration by Fieldwatch

- Beehive placement can be done via GPS locator or manual “point ‘n click” with mouse or screen touch; no drawing required;
- Hives are identified with a 1/2 acre circle and information pin; the size of the circle can be customized for state and province specific purposes;
- Contact information is also collected and provided to applicators to facilitate communication regarding spray activities;
- For commercial beekeepers, multiple beehives can be submitted at same time instead of separate submissions;
- There is a "time stamp” included for indicating active dates of a hive in a particular location;
- Posting of beehive locations and contact information on the public map is optional; map and contact information can be limited to the applicators registered with FieldWatch and state/province agriculture agency personnel;
- Submissions are approved by the state or province agriculture agencies to help preserve the accuracy and integrity of the submitted data;
- FieldWatch provides ongoing service support to users and provides data management support which further helps with data accuracy;
- The program utilizes "mobile optimization" so it adjusts to screen size and can be used on desktops, tablets and phones;
- There is now a mobile ap for tablets and phones that is being launched for registered users to better manage their hives while in the field;
- Flags and field signs are available for purchase by beekeepers with approved sites;
- For applicators registered with FieldWatch programs:
 - see all the beehives registered in BeeCheck
 - get automatic email notifications of new beehives approved in their designated area
 - Members can get data live streamed into their application software so it is always current
- Ideal for pollinator protection plans to facilitate awareness and communication between growers, beekeepers and applicators.
