

Animal Industry

Prevention and control of animal disease and theft through six main programs. (801) 538-7161

1. Animal health
2. Meat and poultry inspection
3. Livestock inspection
4. Fish health
5. Elk farming and elk hunting parks
6. Veterinary diagnostic labs



Plant Industry & Conservation

Ensures disease and pest free plants, grains, seeds, as well as properly labeled agricultural commodities, and the safe application of pesticides and farm chemicals. Assist farmers and ranchers in caring for and enhancing Utah's natural resources. (801) 538-7123

1. Insect control
2. Fertilizer and Feed
3. Seed & grain inspection/testing
4. Pesticide applicator licensing and product registration
5. Fruit & vegetable inspection & grading
