TO REGISTRANTS OF COMMERCIAL FERTILIZER PRODUCTS IN THE STATE OF UTAH

The Utah Commercial Fertilizer Control Act requires that all fertilizers or soil amendments must be properly registered when being manufactured, delivered, distributed, sold, or offered for sale in the State of Utah. All registrations of fertilizers or soil amendments, and any other product defined as fertilizer in the State of Utah expires on December 31 of each year. Applications for product registration should be on file before January 1 of each year.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION, READ CAREFULLY!

Registration requirements for all fertilizers and soil amendments:

- · Name, address and phone number of registrant
- Registered Product label showing guaranteed analysis
- · Registrant must identify "Waste-Derived Fertilizers". A waste derived fertilizer is a commercial fertilizer derived from an industrial byproduct or other material that would otherwise be disposed of. This may include solid or hazardous wastes, but does not include biosolids or wastewater.
- Provide laboratory report or other documentation verifying levels of non-nutritive metals (including but not limited to arsenic, cadmium, mercury, lead and selenium)
- Unlawful to distribute any waste-derived fertilizer(s) not identified by the registrant, penalty \$5,000 fine
- Include your web site address and note if labels are on the web site

The registration fee for each fertilizer product is \$60.00 with no maximum.

Your cooperation with the above items will expedite the registration of your product(s) and allow the Department to better serve you and the consumers of your products.
