

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS  
WEIGHTS AND MEASURES REGISTRATION PROGRAM

1. How do I know how many fuel dispensers our facility has in commercial use?

These devices are counted as individually metered grades per side of dispenser, including diesel.

2. If I have devices in more than one category, which category am I charged under?

Your registration fee will be determined by the category in which you have the **most** devices.

3. If I have 3 grades of gas on each side of a multi-product dispenser (MPD), how many fuel dispensers do I register?

You have six fuel dispensers, as they are counted as individually metered grades per side of dispenser, including diesel.

4. If I have 3 grades of gas and diesel on each side of the MPD, how many fuel dispensers do I register?

You have eight fuel dispensers, as they are counted as individually metered grades per side of dispenser, including diesel.

If I have 4 MPD's how many fuel dispensers do I register? It depends on how many individual metered grades per side of dispenser, including diesel are a part of the MPD.

5. What is a load-receiving element?

That element of a scale that is designed to receive the load to be weighed; for example, platform, deck, rail, hopper, platter, plate, and scoop.

6. If I have 2 load receiving elements, how many scales do I register?

You will register 2 scales.
