

Pictured above are: an area in Southwestern Utah damaged by wildfire (left), and the same area, three years later, following a reseeding project that added grasses and forbs (right). The increase in grass cover and decrease in bare ground (see data table below) will result in less soil erosion and greater forage opportunity for livestock and wildlife.
