- The department shall have complete and unrestricted access to all land, buildings, and other structures used to process industrial hemp.
- The applicant shall apply for an industrial hemp transportation permit at least five business days prior to movement for each day and each vehicle used to move industrial hemp and industrial hemp products.
- The applicant shall not sell or transfer living plants, viable plants, viable seed, leaf material or floral material to any person not licensed by the department.
