

Dog and Cat Evacuation Kit Checklist

Basic Supplies

- Pet carrier
- Leash or harness
- Collar with ID
- Muzzle
- Waterproof container
- Bedding, blanket, or towel
- Toys

Phone Numbers

- Veterinarian
- Boarding facility
- Pet-friendly hotels

Medications and First Aid

- List of current medications and doses
- 2 week supply of medication
- Basic first aid kit (see right)
- 1 month supply of flea, tick, and heartworm preventative

Records

- Rabies certificate
- Vaccination and health records
- Microchip and paperwork
- Most recent heartworm test (dogs)
- Most recent FeLV/FIV test result (cats)
- Photos of you and your pet

Feed and Water

- 1-2 week supply of food
- 1-2 week supply of water
- Non-spill food and water dishes
- Manual can opener
- Supplements (only if essential)

Waste Management

- Litter and litterbox (cats) (you can use disposable aluminum roasting pans)
- Cage liners (dogs)
- Paper towels
- Plastic bags
- Disinfectant

Basic First Aid Kit

(from ASPCA)

- Digital Thermometer
- Small flashlight
- Absorbent gauze pads
- Adhesive tape
- Cotton balls or swabs
- 3% hydrogen peroxide
- Ice pack
- Disposable gloves
- Scissors with blunt end
- Tweezers
- Antibiotic ointment
- Oral syringe
- Liquid dish detergent (for bathing)
- Towels
- Alcohol wipes
- Styptic powder
- Saline eye solution
- Artificial tear gel
