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Important Information

Qualifying Party (QP):

Utah Law 4-14-111(3)(d) requires a Qualifying Party for each Commercial Pesticide Business License. There are two ways to become the Qualifying Party for the business:

1. Obtain a valid Utah Commercial Pesticide Applicator License and provide evidence of possessing a valid Pesticide Applicator's License (Commercial, Non-Commercial, or Private) for at least two full years during the past ten years.
2. Obtain a valid Utah Commercial Pesticide Applicator License and provide evidence of an Associate Degree (or higher) in a field related and applicable to pesticides, such as; Agriculture, Biology, Chemistry, Entomology, etc. UDAF has discretion in deciding which degrees may be acceptable for a Qualifying Party.

The Qualifying Party Acknowledgement Form must be completed, initialed, signed, and submitted with this form before a license may be issued.

Fee:

The Commercial Pesticide Business License fee is \$110.00 per license. This license fee is required for the initial license and for each subsequent license renewal. Each license is valid for a period of up to three years. Each business location must have their own Commercial Pesticide Business License and licenses are non-transferable.

Employee Information:

The Commercial Pesticide Business is responsible for entering, removing, and maintaining current employee information. Here are the required steps:

1. Go to our website at ag.utah.gov
2. Go to Online Services
3. Renewals for Licenses, Permits, and Registrations
4. Click on Blue & White Certificate
5. Go to My Licenses/Permits
6. View My License/Permit
7. Enter Your License/Permit Number: 4000-_____
8. Enter Your PIN (Click on PIN Recovery, if you don't know your PIN)
