

Backyard Poultry Evacuation Kit Checklist

Basic Supplies

- Pet carrier, cardboard box, or plastic tote with ventilation
- Flashlight
- Waterproof container
- Tarp or drop cloth
- Pine shavings
- Roost
- Paper towels
- Plastic bags
- Disinfectant
- Brooder lamp or heating pad

Medications and First Aid

- List of current medications and doses
- 2 week supply of medication
- Basic first aid kit (see right)



Emergency Coop Repair Kit

- Tarps
- Drill and screws
- Flashlight
- Zip ties
- Rope
- Bungee cords
- Hammer and nails
- Duct tape
- Work gloves

Feed and Water

- 1-2 week supply of food in waterproof containers
- 1-2 week supply of water
- Non-spill food and water dishes
- Vitamins
- Electrolytes

Phone Numbers

- Regular Veterinarian
- Emergency Veterinarian
- Chicken rescue or kennel
- Friends, family, or neighbors that can take your chickens
- Cooperative extension

Basic First Aid Kit

- Absorbent gauze pads
- Adhesive tape or vet wrap
- Bandages
- Sterile saline
- Epsom salt
- Corid
- Electrolytes
- Blu-Kote
- Antibiotic ointment
- Hemorrhoid cream
- Vaseline
- Styptic powder
- Super glue
- Nail clippers
- Disposable gloves
- Scissors with blunt end
- Tweezers
- Eye dropper or syringe
- Plastic basin or dishpan (soaking tub)
- Baby shampoo
- Paper towels
