**Zone:** Unknown

**Color:** Yellow

**Bloom Time:** August through September

**Plant Type:** Shrub

**Mature Height:** 2-7' tall

**Mature Spread:** 3-5' wide

**Water Use:** High

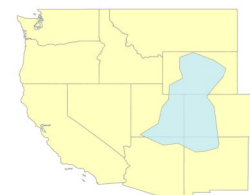
**Soil Type:** Deep alkaline soils

**Range and Native Habitat:** The spearleaf rabbitbrush occurs at mid to low elevations from the Colorado plateau north to Montana. It prefers plains and foothills in moist, alkaline areas such as along riverbanks, margins of alkaline streams, and other moist, low-lying habitats.

**Suggested Maintenance:** This species requires little maintenance. Propagation is best by seed.

**Other:** The spearleaf rabbitbrush has green stems that become tan to gray as it ages. Little has been documented on this species.
