



Utah Food Security Grant Ranking Criteria

The Utah Department of Agriculture and Food

- ____/5 Requests are reasonable
- ____/10 Agricultural Sector: These Areas are Worth Additional Points
- Meats & Poultry
 - Fruits & Vegetables
- ____/10 Greater cost-matching funds provided by the applicant
- 50% cost-match = 10 pts
- ____/10 Proposal demonstrates a significant potential to increase consumer access to Utah-grown and processed agricultural products
- ____/15 Project timeline - how quickly will the project be implemented and begin having an impact on food security?
- Within 6 months = 15 pts
 - 6 months to one year = 5 pts
- ____/15 Percentage of ingredients sourced from Utah-grown/raised products
- 51-70% = 5 pts
 - 71-85% = 10 pts
 - 86-100% = 15 pts
- ____/15 Applicant has a viable business plan/business model and is not reliant on ongoing grant funding
- ____/20 Proposal demonstrates a significant potential to increase applicant's processing and/or storage capacity and will have a strong impact on the overall food supply chain in Utah.
