

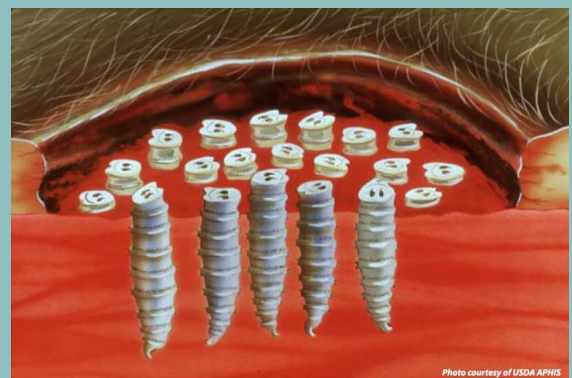
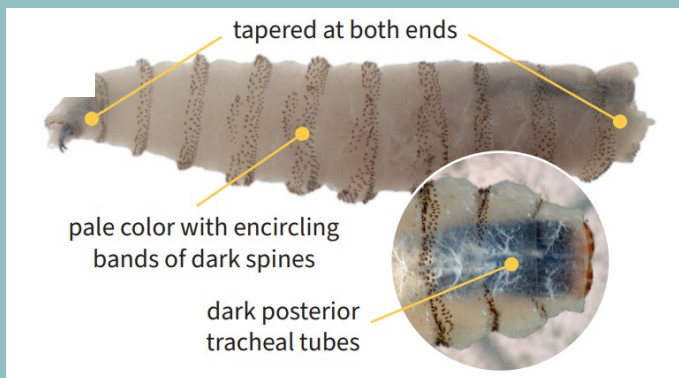
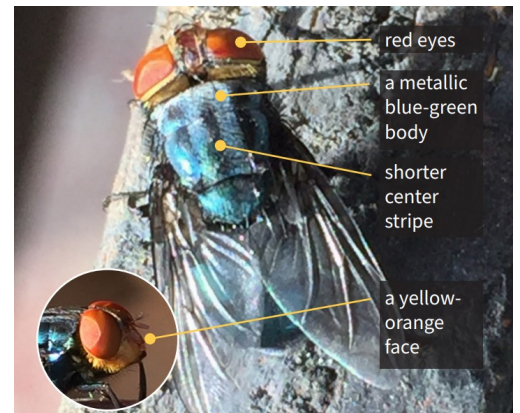


New World Screwworm Identification Guide

What to Look For

New World Screwworm (NWS) can affect any warm-blooded animal. As you care for your animals, keep a careful eye out for signs of NWS. The following are conditions where NWS may be present:

- Horrible smell of death
- Wound of any size
 - New or pre-existing
 - Nostrils, eyes, ears, mouth, genitals
- Dripping pus or serum
- Moving maggots burrowed into the wound
- Animals in pain, depressed, or off-feed
- Head shaking / scratching behavior
- Possible white egg mass at the edge
- Green/blue iridescent flies (orange/red eyes) the size of a house fly
