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Closed-Door Pharmacies

Dr. Licensees,

This industry bulletin serves as an outline of the requirements for closed-door pharmacies. The department may issue only one closed-door medical cannabis pharmacy license before July 1, 2027 to an existing medical cannabis pharmacy. Please note that the department is not accepting applications at this time. An update will be provided when it opens later this year.

The following information includes the requirements in obtaining a closed-door pharmacy license:

A home delivery medical cannabis pharmacy may open a single closed-door medical cannabis pharmacy.

A home delivery medical cannabis pharmacy may not open a closed-door medical cannabis pharmacy unless the home delivery medical cannabis pharmacy has an operating plan that includes a closed-door medical cannabis pharmacy; and obtains a license issued by the department for a closed-door medical cannabis pharmacy.

An entity that owns multiple home delivery medical cannabis pharmacies may open only one closed-door medical cannabis pharmacy.
