Medications and First Aid

Feed and Water

- ☐ 1-2 week supply of food
- ☐ 1-2 week supply of water
- ☐ Non-spill food and water dishes
- ☐ Manual can opener
- ☐ Supplements (only if essential)

Waste Management

- ☐ Litter, litterbox and scoop (cats)
- ☐ Cage liners (dogs)
- ☐ Paper Towels
- ☐ Plastic Bags
- ☐ Disinfectant

Basic First Aid Kit

- ☐ Digital Thermometer
- ☐ Small flashlight
- ☐ Absorbent gauze pads
- ☐ Adhesive tape
- ☐ Cotton balls or swabs
- ☐ 3% hydrogen peroxide
- ☐ Ice pack
- ☐ Disposable gloves
- ☐ Scissors with blunt end
- ☐ Tweezers
- ☐ Triple Antibiotic ointment
- ☐ Oral syringe
- ☐ Towels
- ☐ Alcohol wipes
- ☐ Corn Starch (to stop nail bleeding)
- ☐ Saline eye solution
- ☐ Artificial tear gel
