PERMITTING REQUIREMENTS FOR HPAI POSITIVE DAIRIES



HPAI PERMITTING

HPAI positive dairies must get a permit from the Utah State Veterinarian to move live animals or raw hospital milk off of the dairy. To get a permit, go to bit.ly/UDAFPermit or use the QR code to the right.



Permits are required for:

- Bull calves
- Heifers
- Dry cows
- Cull cows
- Raw hospital milk

Lactating cows may not move off of a positive premises except to go to slaughter.

INFORMATION TO GET A PERMIT

- Your dairy's name, address, phone number, and email
- Type of animal that is moving (or raw hospital milk)
- Number of animals or loads of milk
- Date of movement
- Destination name, address, and phone number
