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Measuring Outdoor & Indoor Cultivation Grow Areas

Dear Licensees,

This industry bulletin serves as an outline on measuring outdoor and indoor grow areas. Both licensees and the department shall measure cultivation grow areas as outlined below. The department will use a measuring wheel or a measuring laser for all measuring purposes unless otherwise identified.

To measure indoor cannabis canopy area, measure the table or tray from corner to corner, or if the plants are in pots on the floor, measure the total growing area from corner to corner. Walkways and open areas wider than six feet should not be included. Each level of a vertical canopy should be measured separately.

To measure outdoor canopy grow area, if planted in the ground measure the area from corner to corner including space in between the rows to determine the total acreage of growing canopy. Do not include walkways, open areas, or roads within the fields/grow area that are a minimum of six feet wide. If cannabis is planted in pots or in raised beds, the width and length of each bed including 6 inches on all sides (to account for overgrowth on the bed or pot) shall be measured to determine the total acreage of grow canopy. If potted plants or raised beds overhang over six inches when checked during the growing season, measurements may be reevaluated.
