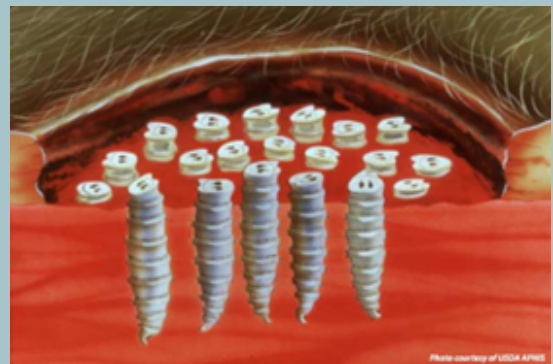
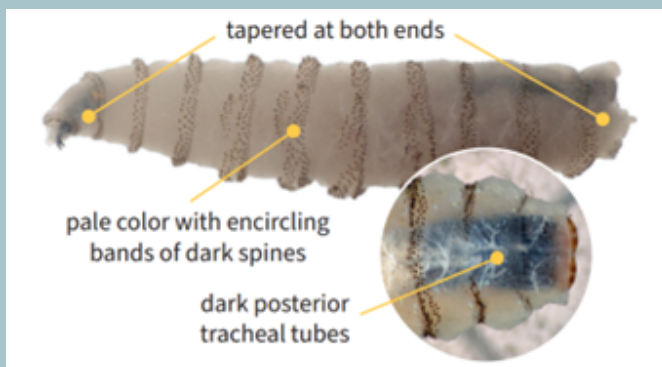
Identification Guide



WHAT TO LOOK FOR

New World Screwworm (NWS) can affect any warm-blooded animal. Signs of NWS include:

- Horrible smell of death
- Wound of any size (New or pre-existing)
- Moving maggots burrowed into the wound
- Possible white egg mass at the edge
- Maggots around nostrils, eyes, ears, mouth, genitals
- Dripping pus or serum
- Animals in pain, depressed, or off-feed
- Head shaking / scratching behavior
- Green/blue iridescent flies (orange/red eyes) the size of a house fly
