Sample Submission Guidelines:

1. **Sample Quantity:** Provide 2.5 to 3 pounds of material per sample, filling a gallon-sized bag completely. Insufficient sample amounts may limit the scope of testing and result in incomplete data.
2. **Personal Identification:** Clearly label each sample with your name.
3. **Sample Identification:** Assign a unique ID to each sample for tracking purposes. This can include identifiers such as bin numbers, field designations, grower names, or other relevant codes.
4. **Grain Type:** Indicate the specific grain type on each sample. Examples include wheat, barley, corn, or rye.
5. **Payment Instructions:** Payment must accompany the samples upon submission. Alternatively, contact the UDAF Grain Inspection to establish an account prior to submission.
